### *Lobster Calypso*

At first glance you could be mistaken for thinking that *Lobster Calypso*, by local author David Andrews, is a children's book. It isn't.

*Lobster Calypso* is action from the very opening chapter. Our accidental hero is Brett Wrelton, an experienced yachtsman and businessman. His life seems to be great and the offer of a free yacht as payment for a relatively simple 'job' seems too good to be true. Of course, it is.

Drug runners, assassins, crooked politicians, the CIA, NASA, triads, and Laura, ooh Laura. These were not what Wrelton was expecting but the journey gets more and more complex as the story develops. Brett and his life-saving friend Lester are taken from Antigua to Scotland, Penang to Cornwall, NASA to Portugal in their quest to find a priceless treasure of secret gold.

*Lobster Calypso* is a great read with a 'twisty-turny' plot that teases until the last chapter. I had fun with it and would recommend it to anyone who likes a treasure hunt with action and a strong story line.
